PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT: STATUTORY AUTHORITY is 10-USC-2101. PRINCIPLE PURPOSE is to obtain identification and educational data for processing ROTC State tuition waiver applications. ROUTINE USES are to collect basic information and identify potential 2-year and 4-year program scholarship applications. DISCLOSURE is voluntary, but omission of requested data can impede or terminate further enrollment/scholarship processing. (Information provided will be held in confidence and only released to the U.S. Army or schools directly involved in the processing of the application). RELEASE OF INFORMATION: As an applicant for or the recipient of a tuition or fee waiver award from Southern Illinois University, I understand that the University has the legal authority to release my name and address, the name of my former high school or college, the name of my award, and the awards amount. This release is valid for the period of time the tuition waiver is in effect.

The ISS is awarded on a semester basis. Awarding of the ISS for additional semesters is based on GPA, participation, demonstrated leadership ability, and instructor's recommendation. It may be cancelled if the applicant fails to meet the minimum standards.
