- Applicants must be juniors or seniors in Spring 2006 (at least 60 semester hours earned and acceptance into major's upper division, if applicable)
- Award based on financial need and demonstrated academic achievement.

**M.B. Corlew Memorial Award in Engineering (\$250)**

- Applicants must be sophomores in Spring 2006 (30 to 59 semester hours earned)
- Applicants must have at least 3.0 GPA

**Society of Military Engineers (SAME) Scholarship (\$1,000)**

- Applicants must be enrolled as full-time sophomores or juniors in Spring 2006 (30 to 89 semester hours earned)
- Applicants must be U.S. citizens or possess a permanent visa
- Award is based on information from student's SAME application form, transcript, and a current resume.

**Available to all undergraduate students majoring in Civil, Electrical and Computer, Industrial, or Mechanical Engineering**

**ISPE Harry A. Kluge Memorial Honors Award in Engineering (\$1,000)**

- Applicants must be juniors or seniors in Spring 2006 (at least 60 semester hours earned, acceptance into major's upper division)
- Award based on overall GPA and participation in campus activities.

- Applicants must be Civil Engineering Majors

- Award based on demonstrated academic achievement

- Applicants must be sophomores or juniors in Spring 2006 (30 to 89 semester hours earned)
- Applicants must be enrolled full-time with a GPA of at least 3.0

**Thomas P. Anderson Mechanical Engineering Scholarship (\$1,000)**

- Applicants must be Mechanical Engineering majors
- Applicants must be juniors or seniors in Spring 2006 (at least 60 semester hours earned)
- Award based on demonstrated academic achievements

**Dr. Robert Rutledge Memorial Electrical Engineering Scholarship  
(\$1,000)**

- Applicants must be full-time majors in Electrical Engineering
- Applicants may be juniors, seniors, or graduate students
- Applicants will be selected on the basis of academic merit, and must have a 3.5 GPA in the major, and at least a 3.25 GPA overall
