

# Faculty Position

**Southern Illinois University Edwardsville (SIUE).** The Department of Mechanical and Industrial Engineering is seeking to fill a tenure track position in the area of solid mechanics, stress analysis, and design at the assistant professor level. However, other areas of specialty or higher rank may be considered for candidates with exceptional qualifications. The position starts in August 2011. SIUE is a strong advocate of the teacher-scholar model, and therefore, the successful candidate is expected to teach undergraduate and graduate courses in Mechanical Engineering, advise graduate students in master and doctoral levels, conduct research, and participate in service activities. The candidate should have a doctoral degree in Mechanical Engineering or a related area.

The large and beautiful SIUE campus is located about 20 miles from St. Louis, MO. The Engineering Building, completed in 2000, houses Mechanical Engineering laboratories with state-of-the-art equipment. An annex of the Engineering Building is being designed and is expected to be built in the near future to accommodate the growth of the engineering programs. The current faculty members in Mechanical Engineering are actively engaged in both fundamental and applied research. A number of them are also actively involved in the editorial boards of premium technical journals.
