Scholarships

Both scholarships are highly competitive.

Thomas P. Anderson Scholarship provides tuition and fees for one spring semester. It is awarded to one student per year. For those with tuition already paid through other grants or scholarships, \$1,500 cash will be awarded.

Evan David Allen Scholarship provides one to three students with \$2,000 to \$6,000 each towards tuition and fees.

Eligibility

Must be junior or senior with mechanical engineering major and a GPA of at least 3.0. Preference will be given to applicants without significant amount of scholarship or grants.

Special requirement for Allen Scholarship: The applicants' permanent residence must be in one of the following 36 counties of Southern Illinois: Alexander, Bond, Clay, Clinton, Edwards, Effingham, Fayette, Franklin, Gallatin, Greene, Hamilton, Hardin, Jackson, Jasper, Jefferson, Jersey, Johnson, Macoupin, Madison, Marion, Massac, Monroe, Montgomery, Perry, Pope, Pulaski, Randolph, Richland, St. Clair, Saline, Union, Wabash, Washington, Wayne, White, and Williamson.

Responsibilities:

Each award recipient must write a letter to the donor introducing his or her background, and explaining how the scholarship made a difference in his or her education in SIUE. The letter should be submitted to the Chair of Mechanical Engineering who will forward it to the donor. The recipients may also be asked to attend a lunch meeting with the donor organized by the School of Engineering.
