For those with a Ph.D. in Math Education, we require a Master's in Mathematics or Statistics.

The Department of Mathematics and Statistics has 23 full time faculty members and offers undergraduate programs in mathematics, applied mathematics, statistics, actuarial science, and secondary education, and master's programs in mathematics, statistics and operations research, and applied and computational mathematics.
