The Department of Mathematics and Statistics offers a number of teaching assistantships, which carry a tuition waiver and a stipend for the academic year. Summer support is available on a limited basis. Students whose native language is not English need to have a high level of proficiency in English. Normally, a TOEFL score of at least 600 and an oral interview is required. The Graduate School also grants a number of competitive Graduate awards, which consists of a fellowship and no teaching duty. Furthermore, the Office of Student Work and Financial Assistance administers additional financial assistance. Students are advised to contact these offices for further information.

Strict priority will be given to active students in good standing in the Department of Mathematics and Statistics, that is students who consistently take two or more graduate courses in the Department during each term and maintain a GPA of at least B (students are expected to take no more than four courses overall during each term).
