RE: Number of Times A Required Course May Be Taken

The Policy Committee approved the following policy on November 19, 2007.

*Students are allowed at most 3 earned grades (A, B, C, D, F, WF, UW) per required math course. If the third earned grade is not at least a C, the student will be dropped as a major with specialization requiring that course. The student will not be able to declare a major with specialization in any area that requires the said course for at least one calendar year. Readmission to the Department requires passing the said course with a grade of C or better and is subject to approval of the Department committee designated by the Policy Committee.*

Rationale:

- This policy may encourage students to put forth more effort when retaking a course.
- This policy would have no impact on the number of W's a student could earn in a course.
- This policy would allow students to earn 3 grades less than C in a required course in one area of specialization but still graduate from another area within the department that does not require that course, provided that the GPA is at an acceptable level.

Note: If this policy is approved it will be effective only with newly entering students.
