Minimum Academic Qualifications for Membership in Psi Chi includes an overall GPA of 3.00 and a Psychology GPA of 3.25. The number of hours required in psychology include completion of 9 semester hours (6 of the 9 semester hours must have been completed at SIUE), or 6 semester hours completed at SIUE and current registration for at least 3 additional semester hours of psychology.
