

A student must declare Studio Art first before being considered for the Bachelor of Fine Arts degree in Art & Design.

Declaring a Studio Art Major: To declare a major in Studio Art, it is necessary to have:

1. Completed all Academic Development courses required by the University.
2. Completed any required courses to address high school deficiencies.
3. A cumulative grade point average of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale).

To apply for the Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA) in Art & Design, it is necessary to have:

1. A completed application on file with the Art & Design Department;
2. A portfolio submitted to the Art & Design Department;
3. A cumulative grade point average of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale) and a 3.0 grade point average in studio courses.
