Minor/ELECTIVE must consist of 29 hours. It is possible to pursue a double major or have two minors that utilize the hours allowed for elective/minor within this major. Students are encouraged to select PHIL 325 and ANTH 305, Studio Art, Museology, and other courses in nonvisual arts and history. Studio work is encouraged and additional language study advised.

Declaring an Art History Major: To declare a major in Art History, it is necessary to have:

1. Completed all Academic Development courses required by the University;
2. Completed any required courses to address high school deficiencies;
3. A cumulative grade point average of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale).
