- # If SPC 370 is taken instead of SPC 201, 213, or 323, then students must choose an additional course to meet the Distribution Fine Arts & Humanities general education requirement. If SPC 103 or 370 is not taken, then a course from the list of Intergroup Relations in the current SIUE catalog must also be taken.
- * Students may choose to use electives to complete a minor or an area of focus related to their interests in Health Education. These informal focus areas include, but are not limited to: Adolescent Health, Global Public Health, Environmental Health, Gerontology, Minority Health, or preparing for a Nursing or Physical Therapy program. Declaring a Community Health Education Major: To declare a major in Community Health Education, it is necessary to have:

1. Completed all Academic Development courses required by the University;
2. Completed any required courses to address high school deficiencies;
3. Completed ENG 101 and ENG 102 with grades of C or better;
4. A cumulative grade average of at least 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale).
