Declaring an Economics Major: To declare a major in Economics, it is necessary to have:

1. Completed all Academic Development courses required by the University;
2. Completed any required courses to address high school deficiencies;
3. A cumulative grade point average of 2.0 (on a 4.0 scale) in all course work taken at SIUE.
