Overall, students must take five 400-level English courses. No more than five 200-level English courses can count toward the major. Three courses in English (British) literature are required; two courses in American literature (including one at the 400-level) are required. Only courses in which the student receives a C or better will be accepted for credit toward the English major.

Application for Major: To apply for a major in English, it is necessary to have:

1. Completed all Academic Development courses required by the University;
2. Completed any required courses to address high school deficiencies;
3. A cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0 (on a 4.0 scale).

Department of English Requirements for the Major

- ◆ **Language Systems** -- 3 hours required. Students may choose from ENG 369, 400, or 403.
- ◆ **Literary Theory** -- 3 hours required. Students may choose from ENG 301 or 495.
- ◆ **Major Authors** -- 3 hours required. Students may choose from the following courses: ENG 307, 404, 471a, 471b, and 473. A course on Shakespeare is strongly recommended.
- ◆ **Surveys** -- 9 hours required. Students must take ENG 208 and select two additional courses from the following: ENG 209, 211, or 212.
- ◆ **Electives in English** -- 9 hours required. Any English course number 200 or higher.
