2. Interpersonal Communication Track

Requirements: SPC 201, 323, 433, 434, 464, and 3 SPC electives
 Recommended Electives: SPC 203, 210, 305, 311, 331, 370, 423, and 430

3. Public Relations Track:

Requirements: SPC 213, 313, 315, 413, 414, and 3 SPC electives
 Recommended Electives: SPC 201, 203, 210, 300, 311, 331, 370, 403, 430, 434, and 491

Declaring a Speech Communication Major: To declare a major in Speech Communication, it is necessary to have:

1. Completed all Academic Development courses required by the University;
2. Completed any required courses to address high school deficiency courses;
3. Completed SPC 103 and SPC 105 with a grade C or better;
4. A cumulative grade average of at least 2.0 (on a 4.0 scale).
