 Requirements: SPC 201, 323, 433, 434, and 464  
 Recommended Electives: SPC 210, 305, 331, and 423
  3. **Public Relations Track:**  
 Requirements: SPC 213, 313/315, 413, and 414/415  
 Recommended Electives: See Public Relations Adviser

Declaring a Speech Communication Major: To declare a major in Speech Communication, it is necessary to have:

1. Completed SPC 103 and SPC 105 with a grade C or better;
2. Completed all Academic Development courses required by the University;
3. Completed any required courses to address high school deficiency courses;
4. A cumulative grade average of at least 2.0 (on a 4.0 scale).
