Declaring a Speech-Language Pathology & Audiology Major: To declare a major in Speech-Language Pathology & Audiology it is necessary to have:

1. A cumulative grade point average of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale) on all college level work.
2. Completed 42 hours of college-level course work.
3. Admission to the program.

Admission to the Program: Admission to the program is a competitive process and not all applicants will be admitted. Students must submit the following information to the program:

1. A 200-word self statement
2. A one-page resume
3. Transcripts
4. Application for admission, available from Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology Program, online at www.siu.edu/education/secd/undergrad/slp.shtml#test2.

Applications for fall admission are accepted twice a year. Applications must be received by January 30th or June 1st for the following fall admission.

Retention Policy

Students must maintain a 3.0 GPA to remain in the program. In addition, students must receive a B or better in SPPA 201 and grades of C or higher in all other course work required for the major, including 12 hours in related areas:

1. Child Development
2. Biological Science
3. Physical Science
4. Statistics
