**Declaring a History/Literature/Criticism Major:** In order to declare a major in History/Literature/Criticism, it is necessary to have:

1. Completed all Academic Development courses required by the University;
2. Completed any required courses to address high school deficiencies;
3. Been admitted in good standing or have a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.0 (on a 4.0 scale).
