

## College of Arts and Sciences Department of Mathematics & Statistics

Southern Illinois University Edwardsville, a comprehensive state university 20 miles from downtown St. Louis, Missouri, invites applications for a tenure-track position at the rank of assistant professor beginning August 2016. We will consider applicants who have a strong commitment to teaching, a demonstrated capacity to perform research, and interest in mathematics education. The applicant should have a Ph.D. in Mathematics, Mathematics Education, Applied Mathematics or Statistics. For those with a Ph.D. in Mathematics Education, we require a Master's in Mathematics, Applied Mathematics or Statistics. For those with a Ph.D. in Mathematics, Applied Mathematics or Statistics, preference will be given to candidates with experience in Mathematics Education at the post secondary level. ABDs very near completion will be considered (if Ph.D. is not completed at the beginning of the contract period a one-year term appointment will be made at the rank of Instructor). Duties will include teaching courses in mathematics such as calculus, linear and abstract algebra, and real analysis; teaching courses in mathematics education; mentoring students through senior projects and master's theses; performing research; and contributing to the department, college, and university through appropriate service activities.

The Department of Mathematics and Statistics has 19 tenured or tenure-track faculty members and offers undergraduate programs in mathematics, applied mathematics, statistics, actuarial science, and secondary education, and master's programs in mathematics, statistics and operations research, applied and computational mathematics, and post secondary mathematics education.
