This warm-hearted musical reminds us of the importance of helping others and the happiness found in friends.

SfC, which premiered in 1990, features adaptations of various children's stories using interactive techniques that not only delight children and parents, but also provide a thorough learning experience. FOTAD, a support group for the SIUE Department of Theater and Dance, uses SfC proceeds to help fund merit awards for talented SIUE theater and dance students.
