

## Summary of SIUE Charges

The following information is from the Fall 2011 semester.

The following is an *approximation* of charges an undergraduate exchange student who is taking 12 US credit hours will incur at SIUE in **fall 2011**. (The *exact* fee amounts are not yet available for the fall semester.)

<b>International Matriculation Fee</b>		\$60	\$60

<b>Housing Application Fee</b>		\$25	\$25
<b>Housing Damage Deposit</b>		\$75	\$75
(Deposit is refundable if you check out on time and unit is left clean and in good condition.)			
<b>Fee for early housing contract termination</b>		\$100	\$100
(Sorry! This fee is unavoidable for students attending in fall semester only. Anyone attending both fall and spring semesters will not have to pay this fee.)			
<b>Housing charges for early arrival for orientation</b>	<b>About</b>	\$112	\$175
(Cost is approximately \$18 to \$36 per day until contract starts.)			
<b>Rental Charges for University Housing through fall semester</b>	<b>About</b>	<b>\$1,890</b>	<b>\$2,805</b>
(Depending on your accommodations. Please check your housing contract for your rate.)			
<b>Tuition for 12 hours at SIUE</b>		Waived	Waived
(Normally, tuition for 12 undergraduate hours would be \$5,850; however, you should not be billed for this.)

## Additional expenses

<b>Meals (about \$10/day)</b>	About \$1200
<b>Transportation</b>	Most exchange students spend between \$50 and \$250/month.
<b>Additional travel and sightseeing</b>	Expenditure varies, depending on travel plans. It is common for exchange students to bring about \$2000 to \$3000 for travel.
<b>Miscellaneous expenses, entertainment, and shopping</b>	Depends on students' lifestyle - about \$1000 is common.
