The Program

Our annual travel study program to Germany has been one of the most popular travel study opportunities offered through the SIUE School of Business International Program for the last six years. As a participant, you'll be immersed in another culture while exploring business practices in some of Germany's most prominent cities. In addition, you'll enjoy company tours, automobile factory visits, and cultural activities that enhance international business understanding.

Eligibility

If you meet these criteria, the program is open to you:

- Juniors and seniors in good standing at SIUE
- Minimum 2.25 GPA
- Priority will be given to School of Business students

Credit

You will be enrolled in GBA 489-XXX for three credits during Summer 2010. Upon acceptance you will meet in required pre-trip classes with faculty leaders and other participants for about 6 weeks prior to departure. There may be a required class session after returning.

Course requirements:

- Course is taught in seminar format
 - You will be reviewed based on the value you add to the course.
- Presentation
- Personal Journal
- Final Exam
- Professional, responsible behavior, 24/7, while traveling out of country
 - Your conduct must represent and reflect favorably upon SIUE at all times, including free time

Cost

The cost to you as an SIUE student is approximately \$2600 plus tuition, meals and incidental expenses.

- **First payment of \$1300:** due between Feb. 1 and 4 - **Please do not turn payment in prior to Feb. 1.**
- **Final payment of \$1300:** due between March 30 and April 2 - **Please do not turn payment in prior to March 30.**
- **Financial aid is available.** Please contact the SIUE Financial Aid Office for details.



Included in the \$2600 cost:

- Airfare
- Lodging
- Visas
- Opening & closing dinners

Not included in the \$2600 cost:

- SIUE tuition and fees
- Spending money while traveling to cover:
 - Incidental expenses
 - Most meals
 - Most ground transportation
 - Students who budget very carefully would need to bring at least \$350, but most students bring \$500 to \$700 to cover these expenses. (In 2009, the average participant reported spending a total of \$450.)
