# Illinois - Ukraine

## TRADE & INVESTMENT STATISTICS

### Exports are a Significant Portion of Illinois' Economy

- Illinois exports totaled over \$59.76 billion in 2016.
- Since 2009, Illinois exports have increased by \$18.13 billion, or 43.6%, outperforming the national average of 37.4%
- Illinois is the largest exporting state in the Midwest and the 5th largest exporting state in the U.S.
- All top 10 Illinois export categories have seen gains since 2009
- 9 of the top 10 Illinois export partner countries have seen gains since 2009
- Exports and Foreign Direct Investment supports over 1 million Illinois jobs

### Total Trade between Illinois and Ukraine in 2016

- Illinois exports to Ukraine totaled \$41.2 million in 2016, a 13.0% increase since 2009. Ukraine is Illinois' 64th largest export market
- Illinois ranks 9th among the 50 U.S. states in exports to Ukraine
- Illinois imports from Ukraine totaled over \$29.3 million in 2016, a 136.0% increase since 2009. Ukraine is Illinois' 63rd largest import market
- Illinois ranks 7th among the 50 U.S. states in imports from Ukraine

### Ukrainian Foreign Direct Investment in Illinois

- Illinois ranks #1 in the Midwest as a destination for foreign investment
- Illinois is home to over 1,890 foreign firms that employ more than 319,000 Illinois residents
- Ukrainian firms employ 10 Illinoisans at 2 different locations for 2 subsidiaries
- Ukraine is Illinois' 57th largest FDI partner by employment
