Southern Illinois University

Southern Illinois University (SIU) is comprised of two sister institutions: SIU Carbondale, with a School of Medicine in Springfield, and SIU Edwardsville, with a School of Dental Medicine in Alton and the SIUE East St. Louis Higher Education campus in East St. Louis. The University System, with an annual operating budget of almost \$850 million, enrolls nearly 32,000 students in programs from two-year technical curricula to doctoral programs in a variety of fields. SIUE offers degrees in law and medicine, as well as first professional degrees in dental medicine and pharmacy.

SIU was chartered in 1869 as Southern Illinois Normal University, a teachers' college. In 1947, the name was changed to SIU, reflecting the institution's academic expansion. The University also expanded geographically. As early as 1949, SIU began offering courses in the metropolitan East St. Louis area, which led to the development of SIUE.

A modern and comprehensive post-secondary educational system, SIU offers a broad range of academic programs leading to associate, baccalaureate, masters, specialists, doctoral and professional degrees.

The instructional, scholarship and service missions of the two constituent institutions reflect the needs of the geographic areas in which they are located. The University also is committed to serving state-wide, national and international needs. This commitment is reflected in educational activities located off the main campuses in communities throughout the state. It is also realized through research and training exchanges, and world-wide student exchange programs.

The Board of Trustees governs SIU and sets policy that enables the University to carry out its established missions and goals. The President of the System is its Chief Executive Officer and reports to the Board of Trustees. The University Chancellors report directly to the President and are responsible for the internal operations of SIUE and SIUC, respectively.

Southern Illinois University Edwardsville

Southern Illinois University Edwardsville (SIUE) traces its origin to a recommendation made in 1956 by the Southwest Illinois Council for Higher Education. The Council was convinced that higher education facilities were needed in the Metro East. They hired consultants whose reports documented that need, and they appealed to Southern Illinois University, 100 miles south, to establish satellite campuses.

In 1957, SIU opened two "residence centers" in Alton and East St. Louis. The University expected to enroll 800 students, but actual enrollment reached 1,776. By 1959, the number of students had more than doubled to 3,800, greatly exceeding the capabilities of the physical facilities. This burgeoning population demanded services faster than the University could develop and supply them.

A planning team investigated sites in the Metro East counties and selected one just south of Edwardsville. In 1960, the Illinois legislature authorized a bond issue for construction of a new state university campus. Voter approval came in November 1960. After nearly three years of planning, University officials and area residents attended ground-breaking ceremonies for the first permanent buildings.

In the fall of 1965, SIUE moved onto its new campus just 25 miles from St. Louis—2,660 acres of rolling land and woods dotted with lakes along bluffs flanking the Mississippi River. Much of the land still retains its natural shape. The core campus was designed by the internationally known architectural firm of Hellmuth, Obata and Kassabaum of St. Louis. The brick, slate and granite of the modern buildings complement the terrain and are softened by a carefully designed garden landscape that attracts visitors by its physical beauty. The campus has received several awards in recognition of the successful blend of the aesthetic and functional in a setting that enhances growth and development and is now featured among the top 150 Illinois Great Places by the American Institute of Architects Illinois Council.

Emphasizing teaching, research and public service programs, SIUE is a fully accredited, comprehensive university with nearly 14,000 students enrolled. *U.S.News & World Report Best Colleges of 2014* lists SIUE among the top 10 public

universities in the best Regional Universities Midwest (master's granting) category for the 10th consecutive year. The overall scores are based on the academic preparedness of students, graduation rates, faculty characteristics and the reputation of SIUE in higher education. SIUE is ranked among the nation's Top 50 master's granting colleges by Washington Monthly for contributions to the public good. More than half of SIUE's 90,000 graduates live and work in the St. Louis region. SIUE makes nearly a \$500 million economic impact on the region every year.

The University awards degrees in baccalaureate and graduate programs encompassing the arts and sciences, nursing, education, business and engineering. The Schools of Dental Medicine and Pharmacy award doctor's "first professional" degrees in dental medicine (DMD) and in pharmacy (PharmD). The Schools of Nursing and Education award doctoral degrees in nursing practice (DNP) and educational leadership (EdD). The main campus also includes University Park, a research park established for economic development. The Edwardsville campus is supplemented by campuses in East St. Louis and Alton.

At SIUE, students find comprehensive educational opportunities and a community in which individuals support each other in their search for knowledge and individual development.

School of Business

The School of Business is among an elite 10 percent of business schools worldwide that have earned the prestigious seal of approval from the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB) International. The accounting program holds specialized accreditation by the AACSB. Less than one-third of AACSB-accredited business schools also hold the accounting accreditation. SIUE's proximity to St. Louis, a major metropolitan business center, allows students to participate in professional organizations and seek practical work experience with local firms and government agencies. Each year, SIUE business students find internships, cooperative education opportunities and employment with major corporations like The Boeing Company, Peabody Coal, Nestlé Purina, Edward Jones, Emerson, Enterprise Rent-a-Car and Monsanto, and scores of small- and medium-sized businesses. Graduates are well prepared to begin productive careers in the fields of international business, management, economics, marketing, human resource management, finance, accounting, and computer management and information systems.

School of Education

School of Education graduates can choose from a variety of career paths in education

and the human sciences: PreK-12 teachers and administrators; fitness and rehabilitation specialists; community and public health specialists; clinical, industrial/organizational, or school psychologists; professionals in speech-language pathology and audiology; and instructional technology experts. Through partnerships with public school districts and local organizations, SIUE students have opportunities to intern in a variety of diverse rural, urban and metropolitan settings. The School's educator preparation programs address the new national standards set by the National Council of the Accreditation of Teacher Education and state standards set by the Illinois State Board of Education.

School of Engineering

The School of Engineering offers eight undergraduate and five graduate programs, as well as a collaborative Ph.D. program with SIUC, making it one of the most comprehensive engineering schools in the region. The School prepares students to meet the growing needs in our region and nation for more engineers, computer scientists and construction managers. Fueling the prosperity of our region, the School has graduated approximately 6,900 engineering professionals. The engineering, information technology and construction companies in the Metropolitan St. Louis area provide exciting, challenging, and well-paid jobs, internships and cooperative opportunities to our students. More than 60 percent of our graduates have taken positions in the St. Louis Metro area. SIUE students are not only educated in the classroom and laboratory, but also through regional opportunities, undergraduate research projects, and student chapters that participate in collegiate contests such as the formula race car, solar car, mini Baja, robotics, steel bridge, concrete canoe and many more.

School of Nursing

Anne Perry, Interim Dean

The School of Nursing offers an excellent learning environment which prepares students for a career as a professional nurse. The School's undergraduate and graduate programs are fully accredited by the Commission on Collegiate

Nursing Education (CCNE), which means that SIUE nursing students can be assured of receiving the highest quality education. The School partners with hundreds of health care agencies in Central and Southern Illinois and the St. Louis region. Performing procedures on electronic simulated patient mannequins, SIUE nursing students can practice required nursing skills in an environment that promotes critical thinking and safe care before actually encountering patients in clinical settings. The undergraduate program is offered at both the Edwardsville and Carbondale campuses. RN to BSN programming is offered online. Graduate programs include nurse educator, nurse administration, family nurse practitioner and certified nurse anesthesia. The doctor of nursing practice, an online program, is also offered.

School of Pharmacy

Gireesh Gupchup, Dean

The School of Pharmacy, the only pharmacy program in Southern Illinois, offers a professional program leading to the Doctor of Pharmacv (PharmD) degree. Established in 2005, the School graduated its first class in May 2009 and received full accreditation in June 2009. Our graduates benefit from an unprecedented demand for pharmacists in a wide variety of professional settings such as community pharmacies, hospitals, the pharmaceutical industry and academia. SIUE pharmacy students work alongside other health professionals. This team approach allows health care professionals to optimize drug therapy and offer the highest quality of patient care. The Express Scripts Drug Information and Wellness Center — the only one in Illinois outside of Chicago — is designed to be a resource for health care professionals and offers wellness initiatives for the community.

School of Dental Medicine

The Southern Illinois University School of Dental Medicine (SDM) is proud of its established tradition of graduating well-prepared general practitioners of dental medicine. Since 1972, the SDM has continued to carry out its mission — to improve the oral health of southern Illinois and the region through education, patient care, scholarship and service. Through the care provided at the University's main clinic in Alton and the community clinic in East St. Louis,

as well as through our community outreach programs, the School of Dental Medicine serves as a vital oral health care provider for residents of southern and central Illinois, and the St. Louis metropolitan region. In 2015, the SIU School of Dental Medicine will celebrate our 40th Anniversary—40 years of graduating outstanding dentists. SDM students participate in a separate Commencement ceremony.

Graduate School

Jerry Weinberg, Dean

The National Science Foundation lists SIUE among the top 20 master's granting institutions in the U.S. in terms of research and development expenditures. The SIUE Graduate School offers 83 areas of study with master's, post-baccalaureate certificates and doctoral degrees in 40 different disciplines. Students prepare for the challenges of their profession in a rich, intellectual learning environment emphasizing research and practice.

Lovejoy Library and Information Services Regina McBride, Dean

Library and Information Services (LIS) provides information resources and technology for teaching, learning, and scholarship. Information resources are available in all formats with a strong preference given to electronic items. Digital collections particularly receive heavy usage.

LIS is a member of CARLI (Consortium of Academic and Research Libraries in Illinois), composed of 145 university libraries. CARLI provides SIUE users full access to the holdings of the 86 CARLI libraries that share a catalog of 38 million item records. Access to OCLC's WorldCat, with more than two billion items held by participating libraries, opens the world to SIUE users.

Library resources are available through social media such as Facebook and Twitter, its mobile website—SIUE Libraries Mobile, and traditional methods. One of the more recent services is 3D scanning and printing.

As in all successful 21st century academic libraries, Library faculty are subject specialists who provide information literacy and technology instruction and direct other faculty in identifying and selecting open access materials, in publishing research locally, and curating collections in the institutional repository.

Honorary Degree



John Simmons

John Simmons earned his baccalaureate in political science from SIUE and his Juris Doctor from Southern Methodist University of Law in Dallas. He is the founder and chairman of Simmons Browder Gianaris Angelides & Bernard LLC, a national law firm headquartered in Alton, Illinois.

Since founding his law firm, Simmons has given time, service and finances that have benefitted SIUE and the surrounding community. In 2004, he donated \$1 million to renovate the SIUE baseball complex. He made a \$10.5 million gift to the University in 2005 to help build the Simmons Cancer Institute at SIU in Springfield and has made significant contributions toward

construction of an SIUE golf training facility.

In addition to donations, Simmons has served as a member and chair of the SIU Board of Trustees. He continues to be highly involved with the University.

Beyond the University, Simmons' philanthropy is evident in the nearly \$5 million the Simmons Family Foundation has awarded to charities and events throughout the St. Louis region. The firm's employees, motivated by Simmons' generosity, started their own Simmons Employee Foundation in 2004, which has donated more than \$1 million and countless volunteer hours to charitable organizations throughout Madison County and beyond.

In addition to donations to charities and nonprofits across the bi-state area, the Simmons Law Firm has donated more than \$10 million to mesothelioma cancer research through the Mesothelioma Applied Research Foundation, the Asbestos Disease Awareness Organization and its national sponsorship of Miles for Meso 5K fundraising events.

Distinguished Service Award



Dixie Engelman

Dixie Engelman, dean emerita of the SIUE College of Arts and Sciences and associate professor emerita of speech pathology and audiology, has been a community advocate and volunteer for more than 35 years. She was the first president and remains a charter member of the SIUE Meridian Society, a group of women who provide leadership through philanthropy and pool their resources to assist SIUE community-based projects. The society makes annual grants each spring to fund SIUE projects that provide direct services in the community. Since 2003, the Meridian Society has distributed more than \$207,000 in awards to more than 100 community projects.

Her dedicated service to the University was exemplified in her willingness to return from retirement in 2005 and donate an extensive amount of time and work as the volunteer chair of SIUE's 50th anniversary celebration. She devoted two years of planning and oversight of more than 100 volunteers from the University faculty, staff and students to make the year-long celebration a success.

In addition to her legacy of service at SIUE, Engelman's philanthropic support extends to volunteering on committees and governance groups at her church. She also served as the first female trustee on the Roxana School Board and as its first female board president. During her winters in Florida, Engelman works closely with elementary school children at an area school. She volunteers through a national program, Guideposts Knit for Kids, knitting sweaters for children in need around the world.

Her commitment to the education and advancement of women inspired Engelman to organize an evening chapter of P.E.O. (Philanthropic Educational Organization). The international nonprofit organization celebrates the advancement of women through scholarships, grants, awards, loans and stewardship, motivating women to achieve their highest aspirations.

History of Academic Regalia

The pageantry of the academic procession is used for many of the formal and significant events at SIUE.

Inherited from the medieval universities of the 11th and 12th centuries when woolen gowns and hoods were worn by scholars for warmth in unheated quarters, the wearing of academic vestments and the procession were not adopted throughout the United States until the late 19th century.

Academic life in the Middle Ages began first in the church, then in the guilds. The teaching guild was the guild of the master of arts, where the bachelor was the apprentice of the master and the dress was the outward sign of privilege and responsibility, designed to distinguish the wearer from the merchants and other townsmen.

Principal features of academic dress are the gown, cap and hood. Both Cambridge and Oxford Universities, since the 15th century, have made academic dress a matter of university control, even to its minor details, and have repeatedly published revised regulations. American universities agreed on a definite system in 1894. In 1932, the American Council on Education presented a revised code which, for the most part, governs the style of academic dress today.

The cap worn almost universally in academic processions is the Oxford cap, better known as the mortarboard. From poetry we learn that the cap of scholarship was square to symbolize a book. A different style, called the Cambridge cap, resembles a large beret.

The use of a dark hood in academic processions is thought to have arisen from the clerical practice of wearing a cap or mantle in religious processions during the 12th and 13th centuries, when universities arose from cathedral schools. Traditionally, gowns are also black. In recent years, however, a number of universities have adopted other hues which signify the school's traditional colors, such as crimson for Harvard, blue for Yale, purple for Northwestern, orange "hash marks" for Princeton, maize with azure blue chevron for the University of Michigan, maroon for the University of Chicago, and cardinal and gold for the University of Southern California. The bachelor's gown is a yoked, closed-front garment with long, pointed sleeves. The master's has long, closed sleeves slit just above the elbow, permitting the forearms to protrude. The doctor's has full, bell-shaped sleeves and is trimmed with velvet panels down the front, and three velvet bars on each sleeve. The color of the panels and sleeves varies to indicate the doctoral field.

The academic hoods, worn around the neck and down the back of the gown, are lined with the official colors of the college or university conferring the degree. The binding or edging of the hood usually represents the subject of the degree.

Mace

The SIUE ceremonial mace was created in 1981 by Michael E. Mason, retired curator of The University Museum, who holds both a Bachelor of Arts and a Master of Fine Arts from this institution. At that time, the president of SIUE (the position now called chancellor) Earl Lazerson instituted traditional, formal regalia for use on significant ceremonial occasions. In 2005, Chancellor Vaughn Vandegrift restored the tradition of the mace at all commencement and other academic ceremonies. A stand was subsequently constructed and, in recognition of the values of the University, engraved brass plagues were added to the ceremonial mace with the words Citizenship, Excellence, Inclusion, Integrity and Wisdom.
