COMMENCEMENT INSTRUCTIONS

1. Arrive at the Vadalabene Center one hour before the start of your ceremony.

Before your ceremony, you will check in and line up in the Student Activity Gym in the Student Fitness Center. As you enter the gym you will receive an SIUE lapel pin to wear on your regalia.

2. Leave your personal belongings at home or with a family member.

Secure storage is not available for personal items (e.g. handbags, car keys, cameras, etc.) and you will not be able to carry them during the ceremony.

3. Check in with the Registrar staff to receive your marching card.

Your marching card will be used when you cross the stage during the ceremony. You will carry it to the stage. You will first have the card scanned, and then you will hand it to the reader, who will announce your name as you cross the platform. Be sure that your card is not damaged and do not leave it on your seat when you go to the stage.

4. Line up within your College/School.

Once checked in, look for your school, marshals (faculty members who will escort you) and staff volunteers in red vests. They will help you find your school and your place in line.

5. Participate in the ceremony!

The faculty marshals and Commencement staff will guide you throughout the processional, during the ceremony and the recessional. You will find a program on your seat to follow along with the ceremony.

6. Make arrangements to meet up with your guests after the ceremony.

Commencement is a large event with many guests! It will be helpful for you to choose a place to meet your guests after the event, as it will likely be difficult to find them in the crowd immediately following the ceremony. Please make sure your guests know that students will exit one end of the gym, and guests will exit the other to avoid congestion. Your guests will not be able to follow the processional of students. Graduates will not be allowed back in the VC gym after the ceremony.

7. In order to make Commencement successful and positive for everyone, please pass along a few reminders to your guests.

- To ensure sufficient seating, each student is invited to bring up to six guests. The ceremony will also be broadcast online at siuetv.com for guests that are not able to attend.
- Please note that guests will not be able to stand in aisles/walkways/doorways during the ceremony.
- Guests are asked to remain seated until the conclusion of the ceremony and not leave early.
- Bullhorns and noisemakers are not permitted at the ceremonies and will be confiscated.
- Guests may take photos from their seats, but will not be permitted to approach the stage or stand in walkways and/or aisles. For the safety of all of our guests, walkways/aisles must be kept clear at all times.

8. Request any special accommodations.

- If you, the graduate, are in need of special accommodations, please contact the Commencement staff no later than two weeks prior to the ceremonies.
- Special accommodations are available for guests on a first come, first served basis.
- Floor seating for guests with disabilities is available.
- Wheelchairs will be available in the lobbies and at Equipment Issue in the Vadalabene Center.
- Sign language interpreters will be provided at the ceremony.
- Guests in need of special accommodations are encouraged to arrive at least 45 minutes prior to the start of the ceremony and seek out an usher or staff volunteer for assistance.

COMMENCEMENT ETIQUETTE

Regalia, Tassels and Honors Cords

Everyone participating in Commencement is required to wear approved academic regalia – gown, cap and tassel. Students not in compliance with standards will NOT be allowed to participate in the Commencement ceremony.

Placement of Tassels

Prior to the ceremony, make sure that your tassel is placed on the right side of your cap. It will be worn on the right throughout the ceremony. Upon conferral of your degree, the Chancellor will instruct the graduates to move their tassels from the right to left side.

Presentation of the Colors

Men should remove their caps and all graduates and guests should stand during the presentation of the flag and singing of the National Anthem.

Conferral of Degrees

All graduate candidates will rise, as a group, when presented to the Chancellor for conferral of degrees by their respective Dean. Diploma covers will be distributed during the ceremony. Actual diplomas will be sent within 14 - 16 weeks after commencement to the mailing address on file. Check CougarNet to confirm your mailing address and avoid delays.

Cell Phones and Other Electronic Devices

To ensure that all guests can hear and enjoy the graduation activities, cell phones and other electronic devices should be turned to silent mode in the line-up and throughout the ceremony. Texting is prohibited during the ceremony.

Commencement Ceremony Photos
