

Thank you for considering working for SIUE Intramural Sports. We take great pride in our programs, and recognize that training excellent officials is a key component to assure that all of our participants have an enjoyable experience. Prior experience is not required for this position, however general sports knowledge will be extremely helpful during the training process.

To become an official for SIUE Intramural Sports you will need to attend the hiring meeting for the sport(s) of your choice. We ask that all attendees review the rules for each sport prior to the hiring meeting and clinic. Sport rules can be found at the link below:

After each hiring meeting we will conduct a hands on clinic that will cover positioning, mechanics, and penalty enforcement. Please come dressed for the weather for outdoor sports and wear athletic attire for all clinics.

At the completion of the last clinic the candidates for the officiating position will be evaluated based on performance, willingness to learn, and attendance. All individuals will receive an e-mail notification informing them of their status as an official. You will be paid for training at the end of the season. If you are not hired, you will not be paid for training.
