Bass Fishing Derby

Rules

- All participants must have their valid SIUE identification card.
- Top Six Largemouth Bass (must be over 15 inches long in order to be weighed) per team will be counted. Rankings will be done by total weight.
- Fish must be caught using a traditional rod and reel combo or cane pole.
- Additionally, the individual who catches the heaviest bass will receive a separate prize.
- Start time will be 6:15am and no sooner.
- All participants must be off the lake by 7:15am and on site for weighing of fish at Cougar Lake Marina. For each minute after 7:15am that a team comes off the lake, one pound will be deducted from their total.
- All fish must be caught within the allotted 1 hour time span in Cougar Lake.
- No live bait may be used.
- Only live fish will be weighed.
- Only SIUE watercraft will be allowed on Cougar Lake. These watercrafts will be given out on a lottery basis.
- Only electric trolling motors will be allowed. They will only be allowed after being approved by a Campus Rec Staff Member. If a team is not selected in the watercraft lottery, they will not be allowed to use a watercraft. No exceptions.

Participants using watercrafts must wear PFDs at all times.
