



# Oral/Facial Bumps, Lumps, & Lesions

### The objectives of the course are to:

1. Spot early pre-malignant lesions.
2. Know the etiology of many of the common lesions.
3. Detect & accurately treat oral/facial lesions.
4. Know how to spot tumors in bone from radiographic surveys.
5. Know how to spot tumors of the salivary gland.
6. Understand how to manage & care for the patient after cancer.
7. Understand the impact of oral/facial cancers etiologic agents on early detection.
8. Know how to use simple detection techniques of diagnosing early oral cancerous lesions. Specific emphasis will be given regarding the use of toluidine blue staining technique & the Velscope mucosal examination system. (The Oral CDX brush biopsy & Visilight systems will also be discussed.)
