JOB DESCRIPTION: Full-time tenure or clinical track faculty position is available in the Department of Restorative Dentistry. This position will be available July 2008. Responsibilities include didactic, pre-clinical, and clinical teaching in Operative Dentistry at the pre-doctoral level, with some teaching at advanced levels and service to the University. For tenure track appointments, independent research and scholarly activities are also expected. The Department is responsible for the disciplines of Operative Dentistry, Fixed and Removable Prosthodontics, Oral Morphology & Occlusion, and Dental Materials. Excellence in teaching is integral to the mission of Southern Illinois University and the School of Dental Medicine.

TERM OF CONTRACT: Full-time, continuing. Full-time, term if clinical track.

QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED: Applicants must have a DDS/DMD degree from an accredited U.S. or Canadian Dental School, and either possess or be eligible for a Dental License in the State of Illinois.
