You should continue to check your registration throughout the semester. PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION COURSES - unless you have declared your major you will not be able to enroll in the following courses:

Elementary Education Majors: SPE 400, EPFR 315, EPFR 320, ART 300A, KIN 330, CI 307 (CI 307 pre-requisite is Admission to the Partnership Program)

Early Childhood Majors-: SPE 400, CI 421 (CI 421 pre-requisite is Admission to the Partnership Program) or SPPA 290(formally 490), EPFR 315, AND EPFR 320

Elementary Education and Early Childhood Partnership Applications – If you are applying to the two Year Early Childhood Education or Elementary Education Partnership Programs, applications will be available sometime the week of January 12th and due on April 3, 2009 for the fall 2009 programs.
