**TESTING INFORMATION:**  
 \*Students must pass the Test of Academic Proficiency with a 240 on each subarea of the test. Students have the option to use previous ACT scores or re-take the ACT test for admission. To use the ACT, students must have a 22 composite score on the ACT Plus Writing taken within 10 yrs.

\* MATH 120 required for all students. The completion of MATH 120 is an Illinois State Board of Ed requirement for ALL Elementary Education majors. MATH 125 or MATH 150 can substitute

\*\*CIED 310 and CIED 311 are required to be completed prior to beginning the Elementary Education Partnership Program.

1. Completion of ENG 101 with a C or higher

3. Combined GPA (all post-secondary work) of 2.5 or higher
4. Completed ALL academic development courses
5. Be in Good Standing at SIUE

**TESTING:** Students must pass all areas of the ILTS Test of Academic Proficiency (TAP), formerly Basic Skills Test, within 5 attempts. Information about the test is available online at <http://www.il.nesinc.com/>. Students now have the option to use their ACT score in lieu of taking the Test of Academic Proficiency (TAP). In order for students to use their ACT score, they must have taken the ACT test with the writing component within the last 10 years and received a composite score of 22 or higher. Please contact the School of Education Health & Human Behavior Student Services office for more information on using your ACT score for admissions requirements. **PROGRAM APPLICATIONS:** students should submit their application online to their program of choice even if they are in the process of meeting declaration requirements or are in the process of completing the eligibility requirements. Applications will be available on our website: <http://www.siu.edu/education/advisement/index.shtml>. Check with your School of Education Health & Human Behavior Student Services Advisor in January to verify your TAP score and grade point average that will be submitted to the admission committee. Please note: applying to the university and to the School of Education Health & Human Behavior is a separate application process.
