Middle Grade Endorsement Worksheet**

Applications for middle grades endorsement must be submitted through your ELIS account by January 31, 2018 to apply under the old rules

Middle School Endorsements may be added to Elementary, Secondary or Special (K-12) endorsements on a Professional Educator License. Middle School endorsements on an Elementary or Special PED allow a teacher to teach the endorsed subject in grades 5-8. Middle School endorsements on a Secondary certificate allow a teacher to teach the endorsed subject in grades 6-8.

All professional education and content-area coursework that forms part of an application for certification, endorsement or approval that is received on or after February 1, 2012, must have been passed with a grade no lower than "C" or equivalent in order to be counted towards fulfillment of the applicable requirements.

All Middle School Endorsements require the following two (2) courses, plus an additional 18 hours in the subject matter:
EPFR 415-The Middle School Learner (3) and CI 407-The Middle and Junior High School (3)
Courses must be taken in the order above. EPFR 415 is a pre-requisite for CI 407
Some programs embed the content of these courses within the program. Current students should check with their advisor.
