Middle Grade Endorsement Worksheet**

Middle School Endorsements may be added to Elementary (type 03), Secondary (09) or Special (type 10) certificates. Middle School endorsements on an Elementary or Special certificate allow a teacher to teach the endorsed subject in grades 5-8. Middle School endorsements on a Secondary certificate allow a teacher to teach the endorsed subject in grades 6-8.

All professional education and content-area coursework that forms part of an application for certification, endorsement or approval that is received on or after February 1, 2012, must have been passed with a grade no lower than "C" or equivalent in order to be counted towards fulfillment of the applicable requirements.

All Middle School Endorsements require the following two (2) courses, plus an additional 18 hours in the subject matter:
EPFR 415-The Middle School Learner (3) and ***CI 407-The Middle and Junior High School (3)***
Courses must be taken in the order above. EPFR 415 is a pre-requisite for CI 407
