To qualify for this scholarship, the applicant must:

- 1. Be a full time student at SIUE with a GPA between 2.75 and 3.5 on a 4.0 scale;
2. Have second, third, or fourth year status;
3. Be a declared major in the Department of Kinesiology and Health Education;
4. Be a student in the Exercise and Wellness program; preferably, or Physical Education Teacher Education program; and health education.
5. Submit a 250-500 (approximately) word personal statement explaining his/her commitment to the major of Kinesiology and Health Education. All other criteria being equal, the scholarship will be awarded to the recipient who most represents Evan James' life and beliefs, including: commitment to a health lifestyle; goal-oriented; active; and commitment to a greater good.
