



Traci Storey Student Scholarship

The Traci Storey Student Scholarship was created to honor the memory of Traci Storey who graduated with an undergraduate degree from SIUE in 2006 and a master's degree in speech-language pathology in May 2008. Traci died in an accident the summer of 2008. The scholarship will be awarded to the recipient who most represents Traci's dedication to the field of speech-language pathology, the National Student Speech-Language-Hearing Association, and to individuals with communication disorders.

Scholarship Amount: \$500

Criteria to apply:

1. Be a full time student admitted to the speech-language pathology program at SIUE
2. Have junior, senior or graduate status
3. Be an active member of the student organization, National Student Speech-Language-Hearing Association (NSSLHA) for at least one year
4. Be nominated by students in NSSLHA
5. Submit an application to the Scholarship Review Committee
