**GPA AND GRADE REQIOREMENTS**

Required minimum GPA's - 2.5 cumulative at all institutions attended, 2.5 at SIUE, and 3.0 in Professional Education courses. Individual grades of C or better are required for each Professional Education course and for each Kinesiology course.

**124 Hours** are required for graduation. **60 Hours** are required from a four year college or university. **30 Hours** are required from SIUE. Students are responsible for tracking earned hours on CougarNet.

**ADDITIONAL STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES**

**Turn in Clock Hours** to OCECA. 100 clock hours of observation are required for certification.

**Application for Clinical Field Experience** forms are required for KIN 330, 435, 461 and 462. The Application must be filed early in prior term to maximize placement options.

**The Content Area Test in Physical Education K-12(#144)** must be passed prior to Student Teaching. Students may register for this test and print the Study Guide as [www.icts.nesinc.com](http://www.icts.nesinc.com). You will need to register at least six months prior to student teaching.

**The APT (Assesment of Professional Teaching) Special K-12(#104)** must be passed prior to Certification. Students may register and print the Study Guide at [www.icts.nesinc.com](http://www.icts.nesinc.com). This test should be taken prior to or early in the Student Teaching semester.

**Apply for Graduation from SIUE** when you have completed 90 hour. This is approximately one year prior to Graduation.
