

American Public Works Association Scholarship
(District 8 Branch)

- Purpose: to encourage students interested in the field of public works
- Amount: \$500-\$1000 at the discretion of the APWA branch chapter
- Eligibility: 1) students admitted to upper-division civil engineering courses and needing more than 35 credits to graduate;
2) U.S. citizens or persons who have applied for U.S. citizenship; and
3) a cumulative overall GPA of at least 2.75. Financial need is not a factor.
- Evaluation/Selection Criteria: 1) interest and potential for success in the field of public works
2) academic record
3) demonstrated activity in Public Works (professional or academic)
4) oral interview by APWA Branch Chapter members and academic staff (at the discretion of the APWA Chapter Branch)
- Procedure: 1) Students obtain an application form from the department office and return it by 30 September.
2) Faculty members submit the application forms of qualified students to the APWA.
3) APWA selects the award winner by 15 November.
4) The award winner is given recognition at the annual APWA Chapter Meeting in December.
