

SATISFACTORY PROGRESS APPEAL : GRAUATION PLAN

Please Read Carefully the accompanying Satisfactory Progress Appeal form and complete the top section including your signature.

You will need to write a statement explaining why you have high hours but have not completed your degree requirements.

You will need to meet with your academic advisor to determine what courses you still need to complete for your degree program and when you will take them. Each course needs to be entered along with the term that you will be taking it and the credit hours that the course earns. The graduation plan must be signed by your academic advisor.

In an attempt to keep your net attempted hours below the federal limit, we must identify any courses on your SIUE transcript, including transfer courses, that do not apply to your major, minor or Gen. Ed. requirements for your current degree program.

Your appeal will not be reviewed until it is complete; including both signatures, your written statement and the course evaluation.
