By December 1, 2009

- Submit your admission application, \$30 application fee, test scores, and high school transcript to the Office of Admissions.

By March 1, 2010

- Apply for financial aid via the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to ensure maximum assistance from all grant, scholarship, loan and work programs.
- Submit this application to Student Financial Aid.

By July 1, 2010

- Receive notice whether you have been selected to receive a Scholarship.

Application purpose:

Southern Illinois University Edwardsville offers a variety of academic scholarships to new and continuing students. These scholarships are made possible in part by gracious gifts from our Alumni, Staff, and Community Supporters. The University and Foundation Scholarship Application enables students to apply for many of these scholarships using a single application.

Eligibility criteria and award values:

University and Foundation Scholarships offer awards with varying criteria, including scholarships for Alton, Dupou and Centralia High School graduates, Phi Theta Kappa members, single parents, and others. Some Scholarships listed require demonstrated financial need through submission of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA.) Award amounts vary, but can pay up to full in-state tuition. A summary of each scholarship is listed on the next page.

Selection:

Complete applications meeting the minimum criteria for any of the scholarships listed will be reviewed by various committees beginning mid-March. Scholarships will be awarded to the students who best meet the criteria for the scholarship. For most scholarships, first preference is given to students with superior academic records who will be enrolled full-time during the period of the award. Notification begins mid-April, and continues until all selections are made, usually no later than July 1. Applicants not selected in the initial round will be considered for any additional funds that become available during the academic year.

Applying for other scholarships at SIUE:

There are a variety of ways to be considered for Scholarships at SIUE. New students will be considered for many scholarships at SIUE simply by applying for admission to the University. In addition to the University and Foundation Scholarships, new and continuing students are urged to check with University Departments for scholarship possibilities.


