
GENERAL INFORMATION

We are pleased that you have expressed interest in Southern Illinois University Edwardsville. This material provides information on applying for admission as an unclassified graduate student. Review it thoroughly before completing the application.

Unclassified graduate students are those not seeking a graduate degree at SIUE. Any applicant who is eligible for admission to a degree program is urged to apply for admission in classified status rather than unclassified status. Only a limited amount of credit earned while in unclassified status may be used to satisfy degree requirements (should the student subsequently be admitted to a degree program) and then only under the conditions stipulated in the transfer credit regulations. The Graduate Catalog and Schedule of Classes are available online at www.siu.edu.

SIUE is committed to student privacy and confidentiality of information. Although submitting your social security number is voluntary, it is recommended as your student identification number. The social security number expedites matching of credentials for admission review and processing.

The deadline for submitting the unclassified application is five working days prior to the first day of the term. Please send the application and fee to: SIUE Application Processing, Office of the Bursar, Box 1042, Rendleman Hall, Room 1101, Edwardsville, IL 62026-1042.

APPLICATION FEE

There is a \$30.00 application fee for all new unclassified graduate applicants and for returning applicants who have not been in attendance at SIUE for nine consecutive terms. Applications received without the fee will not be processed. This fee is nonrefundable. Applicants who decided to change their term of entry after admission may update their file for the next two terms without another application fee. Unclassified graduate students currently enrolled at SIUE are not assessed an additional fee to apply to a program. Payment should be made in U.S. dollars by check or money order payable to SIUE. Payment also may be made online by credit card at www.siu.edu/BURSAR.

PROVIDING ACADEMIC CREDENTIALS

Applicants must have an official transcript mailed directly to the Office of Admissions by the institution granting the baccalaureate degree. This is not necessary for applicants who graduated from Southern Illinois University Edwardsville or Carbondale. Hand carried and faxed documents are not acceptable.
