SUBJECT: FY 2010 First Quarter Report on Externally Sponsored Programs

Attached is the report for the first quarter.

The faculty and staff submitted 108 new grants and received 96 new awards for a total of \$8,110,607 in the first quarter of FY10, exclusive of student financial aid. SIUE received an additional \$4,776,425 in student support for a total of \$12,887,032 in externally sponsored grants and contracts. Comparatively, SIUE faculty and staff propose more grants and receive more awards than do their colleagues at comparable institutions. With continued development and support through our proposal development services, internal grant programs, workshops, COS services, and other support programs, we expect grant activity to continue to be one of SIUE's institutional strengths. Continued support and encouragement from department chairs, deans, and central administration is necessary to sustain the involvement of the faculty and staff in sponsored programs.
