SUBJECT: FY 2009 Final Report on Externally Sponsored Programs

Attached are the summaries and the supporting details for FY 2009 externally sponsored grants and contracts. We are very happy to report that faculty and staff submitted 379 new proposals and received 250 new awards totaling \$29,331,846, exclusive of student aid. This represents an increase of 7.8% over the previous fiscal year. In addition to the \$29.3 million in grants and contracts, SIUE received \$10,256,757 in student aid, for a total of \$39.6 million in sponsored programs in FY 2009.

Grants and contracts helped SIUE address a number of its principle objectives. Grants supported SIUE's Long-Term Goal of a "Committed Faculty and Staff" through record faculty involvement. Out of the total number of tenure and tenure-track faculty, 41% submitted proposals (187 out of 458). This represents an increase of 3% over last fiscal year. Of the 187 faculty who submitted proposals, 42.8% (80 faculty) received awards. Of the awards, faculty and staff received \$8,449,835 in support of research, an increase of 4.3% over FY 2008. Significantly, SIUE faculty successfully competed nationally for these funds receiving grants from the National Science Foundation, the National Institutes of Health, the Joyce Foundation, and the National Endowment for the Humanities. Additionally, the faculty also received research support from state and local agencies, such as the Illinois EPA and the Illinois Department of Natural Resources. These grants funded a broad array of research areas, ranging from the examination of early childhood teacher preparation to investigating the role of atg1 in the regulation of glutamate receptors, the study of Abraham Lincoln and the Forging of Modern America, the examination of maximum power tracking techniques for multiple photovoltaic arrays, and the impact of tobacco use in pregnancy and psychiatric disorders.

Funding from grants and contracts also helped SIUE address the Long-Term Goals of "Active Community Involvement." Faculty and staff received 109 awards for \$19,519,695 million for public service activities. Projects included solar and wind turbine electrical energy generation, screening for oral cancer, prostate cancer detection, reforming early education intervention services and response, summer arts enrichment, fundamental reading, and small business development. Additionally, many of the public service projects addressed the needs of the underserved populations of Metro East St. Louis. The SIUE East St. Louis Center, for example, managed \$16,456,048, an increase of 24.3% over last fiscal year, in grants supporting activities for children and families ranging from Head Start to Upward Bound.

Grants and contracts also helped the University address the Long-Term Goals of "Engaged Students" and of "Innovative Programs." Funded projects supported internships and assistantships for students, summer programs for science teachers, and new curricular developments for the humanities and social sciences.

SIUE faculty and staff propose more grants and receive more awards than do their colleagues at comparable institutions. With continued development and support through our internal grant programs, workshops, new services provided through COS, and other support programs, we expect that grant activity will continue as one of SIUE's institutional strengths. Continued support and encouragement from department chairs, deans, and central administration is necessary to sustain the involvement of the faculty and staff in sponsored programs.
