## Where is Eco-House Located?

Eco-House is a stand-alone house, located on the edge of Cougar Village and Cougar Lake. There are 2 shared bedrooms, 5 private bedrooms, 3 full baths, 3 half baths, living room, full kitchen, laundry area, study lounge, and community space. The house also includes a back patio overlooking Cougar Lake.

## Tell me about the Eco-House.

- Eco-House is considered part of Cougar Village, University Housing's traditional apartment complex.
- The Eco-House is fully furnished and air conditioned. The house has wireless internet, data jacks, and cable television.
- Work directly with University Housing to plan and implement "greening" projects and initiatives related to the Eco House and on-campus housing.
- Eco-House is a co-ed living environment with shared facilities.
- Cougar Village has a number of outdoor recreational areas, like sand volleyball, tennis and more—all accessible to Eco-House residents!
