

Student Government Standing Committees

Finance Board (Permanent)

recommends and monitors the expenditure of student fees.

External Affairs Committee (Permanent)

develops programs to promote a positive university-wide image of Student Government.

- **Student Advocacy Subcommittee** – act on behalf of students' needs and researches topics that concern SIUE students.
- **Public Relations Subcommittee** – coordinates activities between Student Government and SIUE students/local community.

School Spirit and Pride Committee (Permanent)

promotes and enhances school spirit and pride on the SIUE campus.

Student Organizations Advisory Board (Permanent)

reviews constitutions and holds hearings for student organizations petitioning for recognition status and office space. It also maintains an accurate list of petitioning organizations.

University-Wide Committees

Campus Recreation Advisory Committee (Permanent)

advises on the staffing, operations, programs, services and user charges of Campus Recreation.

Curriculum Council (Permanent)

considers all aspects of the undergraduate curricula. Reports to the Faculty Senate.

General Education Committee (Permanent)

reviews the General Education Program.

Graduate School Council (Permanent)

participates in developing curriculum and formulating policies concerned with graduate education, research and financial support for graduate students.

Health Services Advisory Committee (Permanent)

advises Health Services to better serve students.

Intercollegiate Athletics Committee (Permanent)

recommending body for Intercollegiate Athletics program.

Parking and Traffic Committee (Permanent)

advises the Vice Chancellor for Administration on all matters pertaining to Parking Services.

Textbook Service Advisory Committee (Permanent)

addresses any problems with the use of textbooks at Textbook Service and facilitates interaction between operations and users of Textbook Service.

University Housing Advisory Committee (Permanent)

provides a representative voice for residents of Cougar Village and the residence halls.

University Center Board (Permanent)

advisory board to the Morris University Center management staff on policy review, building services, finance and programming.

University Planning and Budget Council Committee (Permanent)

advises the Chancellor about University planning issues.

Honorary Degrees and Distinguished Service Awards Committee

reviews applicants and nominees for honorary degrees and distinguished service awards.

Student Legal Services Advisory Board (Permanent)

oversees the development and operation of the Student Legal Services Program.

Student Publications Advisory Board

selects the editor-in-chief, reviews *Alestle* policies and procedures, conducts annual fee review and program evaluation, reviews budget requests, and resolves complaints against the *Alestle*.

Technology Advisory Council

reports to the chancellor and is responsible for establishing priorities, initiating planning, and making recommendations about information technology developments for the university. It appoints, charges, discharges, and reviews all university-wide computing committees and task forces as it guides university-computing initiatives.
