<b>Nurs 521</b>	<b>Epidemiology of Cancer</b> Examines the physiologic and genetic aspects of cancer prevention, epidemiology, diagnosis, and staging.	<b>3</b>
<b>Nurs 522</b>	<b>Psychosocial Dimensions of Oncology Care</b> Explores current knowledge and research in the psychological, social, and spiritual dimensions of cancer care, along a continuum from diagnosis to death.	<b>3</b>
<b>Nurs 523</b>	<b>Symptom Management in Acute, Chronic and Emergent Oncological Conditions</b> Examines evidenced based nursing care for symptom management in patients receiving cancer treatments.	<b>3</b>
<b>Nurs 524</b>	<b>Treatment Modalities in Oncology</b> Examines cancer treatment options including surgery, chemotherapy, biotherapy, radiation therapy, complimentary/alternative therapy and related clinicals trials.	<u><b>3</b></u>
