

Academic Year 2011-2012 parking permits will be available for sale on July 1, 2011. All vehicles parked on campus must have a current parking permit. The minimum requirement for students is a red permit. Though the deadline for having a current parking permit in the *green, blue and orange lots* is **August 22, 2011**, the **deadline** in the *red, yellow and brown lots* is **August 29, 2011**. Parking permit rates for Academic Year 2011-2012 are:

R11 (Red) – Lots P4, P5, P6, P7, P8, P9, P10, P11, P12, Supporting Srvs., Alton, E. St. Louis - \$102.00
Y11 (Yellow - residence hall students) - BH, EH, PH, WH and lots listed for code R11- \$132.00
Z11 (Yellow – Cougar Village residents) – Cougar Village Lots and lots listed for code R11 - \$132.00
F11 (Brown) – Lot F and lots listed for R11 - \$149.00

NOTE: If most of your classes are in the evening, you may be interested in purchasing one of a limited number of evening permits for \$126.00. If you are a residential student and purchase one of these permits, Parking Services will affix a Housing sticker to it. Additional information about evening permits is available on the Parking Services website or at the Parking Services office.

Graduate assistants will no longer be automatically eligible for green permits. Options for this upcoming academic year are: (1) Register online on the Parking Services website for a limited number of green permits in an exclusive graduate assistant lottery. If you are a University Housing Resident and obtain a green permit through the lottery, a Housing sticker will be affixed to that permit by Parking Services so that it will be honored in the residential lots. The names selected in the lottery will be posted on the website and at the Parking Services office on August 12, 2011. “Winners” may then purchase their permits online and will receive online instruction about obtaining the permit after purchase. (2) Purchase a red, yellow for University Housing residents, brown or evening permit.

Individuals with motorcycles or mopeds may purchase regular hangtags which can be placed in a special case designed to be locked on motorcycle or moped handlebars. The permit may also be displayed from the rear view mirror of a vehicle either with or without the case. Additional information about the special case may be found on the parking website or by contacting Parking Services.

To purchase a 2011-2012 permit, your options are: (Note: You may not purchase a permit if you have outstanding parking citations.)

Online – To purchase the permit via the Parking website at siue.edu/parking , you must enter your Cougar Student ID and pay via Discover, MasterCard or you may choose to post the charge to your student account. A nominal handling fee will be applied if you pay online by credit card. ***However, there is no handling fee if you choose to add the permit cost to your student account.*** Permits purchased online will be available for pick up on the next business day. You will receive online instructions about picking up your permit after purchase.

Mail – Mail the registration form with the appropriate payment (make checks payable to SIUE) to Parking Services, Southern Illinois University Edwardsville, Box 1044, Edwardsville, Illinois 62026-1044. Registration forms and payment authorization forms are available in Parking Services and on the Parking website. Do not mail cash. The permit will be mailed to your permanent address between July 1, 2011 and August 5, 2011. Note: mail requests must be received by August 5, 2011. Please allow for mail time.

In Person – Present a picture identification card, such as your Student ID, at the Parking Services office. Cash, check, Discover, MasterCard, Visa and CougarCard are acceptable forms of payment. This charge may also be posted to your student account.

Lottery – **Between July 18, 2011 and August 11, 2011**, you may visit the Parking Services website at siue.edu/parking to **register, one time only**, in a lottery for a chance to purchase one of a limited number

of **green permits** which are valid for Lot A and Lot E. If you are a residential student and obtain a green permit through the lottery, a Housing sticker will be affixed to that permit by Parking Services so that it will be honored in the residential lots. The names selected will be posted on the website and at the Parking Services office on August 12, 2011. “Winners” may then purchase their permits online. You will receive online instruction about obtaining your permit after purchase.
