Academic Year 2009-2010 permits are currently available in the Parking Services office. Between July 1 and the first day of fall semester, permits for both the current and upcoming academic years will be honored when appropriately displayed in registered vehicles. The minimum requirement for faculty and staff is a blue permit for parking on campus. Only one green, orange or brown permit may be issued to an individual. The 2009-2010 permits are required by August 24, 2009. Enforcement for the fall semester will begin on that date. **For the Academic Year 2009-2010, permit rates for employees are as follows:**

Green (code G10) - Lots A and E - \$135.00

Orange (code O10) – Lots D and G - \$135.00

Brown (code F10) – Lot F - \$135.00

Blue (code B10) – P1, P2, P3, Tract House Locations, Alton and East St Louis -\$103.00

Parking Services is pleased to offer full time employees the opportunity to purchase Academic Year 2009-2010 parking permits by pre-tax payroll deduction during the sign-up period of July 1, 2009 through August 23, 2009. Sign-up and purchase must be made online by accessing our website at <http://www.siue.edu/parking> . There will be no service fee applied for this transaction. Enrollments are for a period of one year and you will have the opportunity to renew each year when you purchase a new permit.

There will be four (4) deductions taken during the months of October and November. Payroll deductions may be made only for the individual employee of SIUE. Deductions may not be made for one's spouse, significant other or dependent.

Individuals with **motorcycles or mopeds** may purchase regular hangtags which can be placed in a special case designed to be locked on motorcycle or moped handlebars. The permit may also be displayed from the rear view mirror of a vehicle either with or without the case. Additional information about the special case may be found on the parking website or by contacting Parking Services.

To purchase a 2009-2010 permit, your options are:

Online – Online payments may be made by Discover, MasterCard or Visa on the Parking Services website at: <http://www.siue.edu/parking>. A nominal handling fee will be applied for that option. You will receive online instructions about picking up your permit after purchase.

Online Pre-tax Payroll Deduction – See second paragraph above.

Mail – Mail the registration form with the appropriate payment (make checks payable to SIUE) to Parking Services, Southern Illinois University Edwardsville, Box 1044, Edwardsville, Illinois 62026-1044. Registration forms and payment authorization forms are available in Parking Services and on the Parking website. Mail registrations must be received in Parking Services by August 7, 2009 Do not mail cash.

In Person – Present a picture identification card, such as your University ID, at the Parking Services office or designated point of sale. Cash, check, Discover, MasterCard and Visa are acceptable forms of payment. School of Dental Medicine employees may purchase permits in the business office at that location. Following are the areas, locations and names of those handling permits sales for three (3) groups of employees at the East St. Louis Higher Education Campus: (1) University Services to East St. Louis, Suite 1055, Bldg. A, Rene Smith; (2) Southern Illinois Collegiate Common Market, Room 1036 A, Bldg. B, Iesha Crawford; (3) IDES, Room 1022, Bldg. E, Mary Ann Pruitt.
