Parking permits for Academic Year 2009-2010 are available in the Parking Services office. All vehicles parked on campus must have a current parking permit. The minimum requirement for students is a red permit. Though the deadline for having a current parking permit in the *green, blue and orange lots* is **August 24, 2009**, the **deadline** in the *red, yellow and brown lots* is **August 31, 2009**. Parking permit rates for Academic Year 2009-2010 are:

R10 (Red) – Lots P4, P5, P6, P7, P8, P9, P10, P11, P12, Tract Houses, Alton, E. St. Louis - \$92.00

Y10 (Yellow - residence hall students) - BH, EH, PH, WH and lots listed for code R10- \$120.00

Z10 (Yellow – Cougar Village residents) – Cougar Village Lots and lots listed for code R10 - \$120.00

F10 (Brown) – Lot F and lots listed for R10 - \$135.00

NOTE: If most of your classes are in the evening, you may be interested in purchasing one of a limited number of evening permits for \$114.00; additional information about evening permits is available on the Parking Services website or at the Parking Services office.

Individuals with motorcycles or mopeds may purchase regular hangtags which can be placed in a special case designed to be locked on motorcycle or moped handlebars. The permit may also be displayed from the rear view mirror of a vehicle either with or without the case. Additional information about the special case may be found on the parking website or by contacting Parking Services.

To purchase a 2009-2010 permit, your options are: (Note: You may not purchase a permit if you have outstanding parking citations.)

Online – To purchase the permit via the Parking website at <http://www.siue.edu/parking>, you must enter your Cougar Student ID and pay via Discover, MasterCard, Visa or you may choose to post the charge to your student account. ***There is no handling fee if you choose to add the permit cost to your student account.*** A nominal handling fee will be applied if you pay online by credit card. The permit will be available for pick up on the next business day. From August 19, 2009 to August 28, 2009, the permit may be picked up at the Information Center in the Morris University Center (MUC). Hours available at the MUC are Mon.-Fri. 8:30 a.m.- 4:00 p.m.; Sat. 9:30 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. You may also elect to have the permit mailed to your permanent billing address on file with the Parking Services office.

Mail – Mail the registration form with the appropriate payment (make checks payable to SIUE) to Parking Services, Southern Illinois University Edwardsville, Box 1044, Edwardsville, Illinois 62026-1044. Registration forms and payment authorization forms are available in Parking Services and on the Parking website. Do not mail cash. The permit will be mailed to your permanent address between July 1, 2009 and August 7, 2009. Note: mail requests must be received by August 7, 2009. Please allow for mail time.

In Person – Present a picture identification card, such as your Student ID, at the Parking Services office. Cash, check, Discover, MasterCard, Visa and CougarCard are acceptable forms of payment. This charge may also be posted to your student account.

Lottery – **Between July 20, 2009 and August 13, 2009**, you may visit the Parking Services website at <http://www.siue.edu/parking> to **register, one time only**, in a lottery for a chance to purchase one of a limited number of **green permits** which are valid for Lot A and Lot E. If you are a residential student and obtain a green permit through the lottery, a Housing sticker will be affixed to that permit by Parking Services so that it will be

honored in the residential lots. The names selected will be posted on the website and at the Parking Services office on August 14, 2009. The green permits may be purchased online. You will receive online instruction about obtaining your permit after purchase.
