SWIC/SIUE Dual Admission Agreement Information and Statement of Intent to Participate

Southwestern Illinois College and Southern Illinois University Edwardsville have entered into a partnership to allow students to apply for admissions to both institutions for the purpose of earning an associate of arts or sciences degree at SWIC while preparing to make a seamless transfer to SIUE to pursue the baccalaureate degree. By agreeing to participate in this dual admission agreement, you will receive many benefits including a waiver of the application fee for SIUE, an ongoing automatic evaluation of your transfer credit each semester, academic advisement as appropriate and periodic program updates.

Eligibility to Participate:

Any SWIC student is allowed to participate as long as the application is completed by the end of their first year at SWIC. This program is designed to accommodate those wishing to pursue to the associate degree and/or the completion of the GECC as defined by the Illinois Articulation Initiative, (IAI), at SWIC, then transfer to complete the bachelors degree at SIUE.

- You must have and maintain a minimum grade point average of 2.0 throughout the completion of both the associate and the bachelor degree.
- You must agree by way of this form, that your academic, advising and financial aid documents are shared as appropriate between SWIC and SIUE.
- You are subject to the same admissions, matriculation and degree requirements of all other SWIC and SIUE students. By making this agreement you are pursuing admission to SIUE and not specifically to an academic department.
- You are subject to all policies and procedures of each institution
- You may end your participation in this program at any time as long as it is done in writing, notifying each partner institution. You will be subject to standard university application procedures and fees upon termination of the dual agreement.

Application Process:

1. Complete the SIUE/SWIC Dual Admission Agreement Application. Return the completed application to the Office of Admissions and Records at SWIC. You will be notified of your eligibility within three weeks from the time of application.
2. Have your high school or GED testing center send your transcript or GED certificate directly to SWIC.
3. If you have taken AP or other college level courses, you will need to have any credit granting institutions submit an official copy of your transcripts to both SWIC and SIUE.
4. You may be required, as any other student, to take an assessment which measures your skills in English, math and reading. This assessment must be taken prior to enrollment in English or math courses at SWIC. The results from the assessment are used to determine the most appropriate courses to ensure your academic success.
