SIUE General Education waivers based on earning an AA/AS/ASA from a participating IAI community college or satisfying the IAI General Education Core Curriculum refer ONLY to General Education requirements for graduation. Course work required for major/minor or degree program is not waived (i.e.: B.A. degree requires one year, 8 semester hours, of foreign language course work). Your academic adviser will guide you in completing major/minor and degree program requirements.
