

Travel Study to Buenos Aires

Summer 2010

Application Requirements

Program eligibility criteria:

SIUE degree seeking student with minimum GPA of 2.5

Successful completion of SPAN 202 by the end of spring 2010

Application Deadline: Applications will be accepted on a rolling basis until **Feb. 15, 2010**. Students are encouraged to apply early. Enrollment will be limited to 12 students.

Application Procedures:

Submit the items 1 – 3 to Julie Beall-Marshall in the Office of International Programs in the Student Success Center, Office 0300.

1. Completed SIUE Travel Study Student Application Form. Form is available online at http://www.siu.edu/studyabroad/pdf/TS_Application_Form.pdf.
2. Statement of Purpose Essay (750-1000 words). Please discuss:
 - a) Your academic and personal reasons for wishing to participate in the travel study program to Buenos Aires.
 - b) How you hope to benefit from participation in this program.
 - c) Any prior study abroad or international travel experience.
3. One letter of recommendation from an SIUE faculty member addressing the student's maturity, responsibility and problem-solving skills. A letter in a sealed envelope may be submitted with the application by the student applicant or the faculty member may send the letter directly to Julie Beall-Marshall, Office of International Programs, Box 1159.
4. Applicants who have not taken a class with the faculty leader, Dr. Carolina Rocha, will be required to meet with Dr. Rocha for an interview.
5. Students approved by SIUE to participate in the program will be contacted by a CEA student services advisor with details about enrolling in the program. You will need to submit a completed CEA application and \$300 non-refundable confirmation deposit through your online MyCEA account by March 15, 2010. SIUE has partnered with CEA for this program and payment of the program fee will be made by students directly to CEA. SIUE tuition will be charged to the Summer 2010 SIUE bursar bill.

Additional SIUE and CEA paperwork will be required from accepted students.
